Student Loan Application Must Include:

- ▶ **Application form (online)**
- ▶ **Canada Revenue Agency Form**
- ▶ **Student Declaration and Consent Form**
- ▶ **Income Confirmation Form
(bring to registration)**

Other forms may be required depending on individual circumstances.

Student Loans - Major Points

- ▶ Students must carry 80% of full course load to receive the Provincial portion of the student loan and 60% for the Federal portion.
- ▶ Deadline to apply - 8 weeks after the first day of classes.
- ▶ Written appeals should be done soon after receiving Notification of Assessment / Reassessment. However, the deadline is 8 weeks from the study end date for that semester.
- ▶ Maximum loan amounts: For provincial loans - \$60 per week plus \$80 per week in nonrepayable grants. For Federal loans - \$210 per week. These amounts are combined into one loan.

How to Get Your Loan

The master Student Financial Assistance Agreement will be sent to you to complete. This agreement will only have to be completed once throughout your program. Some exceptions will apply. Read this agreement carefully, complete the required sections and bring to Canada Post. You will also need to bring the following:

- ▶ **Social Insurance Card**
- ▶ **Void Check or bank, transit, and account number.**
- ▶ **Official Government photo I.D.**

Canada Post will forward the agreement to the National Student Loan Centre.

Notice of your loan eligibility will be sent to the college using electronic confirmation of enrollment. When processed during registration, fees owing to the College will automatically be taken out of the student loan. The amount left over will be deposited into the student's bank account.
